5	SECTION 1. Section 33.171, Natural Resources Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
7	(c) The state is entitled to receive notice of a claim
8	against the School Land Board under this subchapter not later than
9	the 180th day after the day the incident giving rise to the claim
10	occurred. The notice must reasonably describe:
11	(1) the action of the board that affected the littoral
12	<u>owner's rights;</u>
13	(2) the time and place of the board's action; and
14	(3) the nature of the claim, specifying, as
15	applicable, the manner in which:
16	(A) the board's action affected the title to or
17	boundary of coastal public land to the detriment of the littoral
18	<u>owner;</u>
19	(B) the board's action affected an interest in
20	land sought or granted under this chapter; or
21	(C) the board violated this chapter or a rule
22	adopted by the board under this chapter.
23	(d) The notice requirement of Subsection (c) is a
24	jurisdictional prerequisite to the institution of suit under this

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1 section regardless of actual notice, express or implied, to the 2 board or the state.

3 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

(b) The changes in law made by Sections 33.171(c) and (d),
Natural Resources Code, as added by this Act, apply only to a suit
against the School Land Board that is brought under Section 33.171
on or after September 1, 2003.
