## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the receipts from the sale of land by the Parks and

- 3 Wildlife Department
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 13.009, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 13.009. SALE OR EXCHANGE OF LAND. (a) The director
- 8 with the approval of the commission may execute a deed exchanging
- 9 real property or an interest in real property either as all or
- 10 partial consideration for other real property or interest in real
- 11 property. The director with the approval of the commission may
- 12 execute a deed selling real property or an interest in real property
- 13 under the jurisdiction of the department if ownership of the real
- 14 property is no longer in the best interest of the department.
- 15 (b) The department shall receive a good and marketable title
- 16 to all land exchanged under this section.
- 17 (c) All land to be received in the exchange must be
- 18 appraised and if the land to be received is of greater value, as
- 19 determined by an independent and competent appraisal, than the
- 20 state land exchanged, the department may use funds available for
- 21 land acquisitions as a partial consideration for the exchange.
- 22 (d) The receipts from the sale of land under this section
- 23 shall be deposited in the General Revenue Fund [used for improving
- 24 or acquiring other real property dedicated to the same purpose for

## which the land sold was dedicated].

- 2 (e) Notwithstanding any other law or charter provision to 3 the contrary, the department and a municipality may agree to
- 4 exchange park properties under the control or management of the
- 5 department or municipal government on the following conditions:
- 6 (1) the properties to be exchanged shall continue to
- 7 be dedicated park properties and used for park purposes;
- 8 (2) no election is required by the municipality to 9 authorize exchange; and
- 10 (3) all of the provisions of Subsections (a) through
- 11 (d) of this section are complied with by the department.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If it does
- 15 not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes
- 16 effect September 1, 2003.
