A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to authorizing the Texas Department of Public Safety to
3	enter into contracts for the periodic reporting of certain
4	information in the department's driver's license files to certain
5	other persons.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
8	is amended by adding Section 521.058 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 521.058. CONTRACTS FOR DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN
10	INFORMATION. (a) The department may enter into a contract with a
11	person to provide the person with certain information from the
12	department's driver's license files if:
13	(1) the person:
14	(A) is a motor vehicle insurance company, a motor
15	vehicle insurance support organization, or an entity that
16	self-insures its motor vehicles; and
17	(B) is eligible to receive the information under
18	Chapter 730; and
19	(2) the information is requested in connection with
20	one or more of the following:
21	(A) claims investigation activities;
22	(B) antifraud activities; or
23	(C) insurance rating or underwriting.
24	(b) Information provided under Subsection (a) must:

1	(1) be authorized to be released under Section 521.045
2	or 521.046; and
3	(2) relate to the current license status of
4	individuals, traffic law convictions of individuals, or
5	suspension, revocation, or denial actions in connection with
6	individuals' driver's licenses that occur during the period
7	specified in the contract.
8	(c) A contract entered into under this section must require:
9	(1) the person who will receive a report from the
10	department under the contract to:
11	(A) provide the department with a list containing
12	the driver's license number or the full name and date of birth of
13	each individual about whom information is requested; and
14	(B) agree to purchase under Section 521.056 the
15	three-year driving record of each individual included in a report
16	received from the department; and
17	(2) the department to:
18	(A) search the department's driver's license
19	databases to determine which of the individuals on the list
20	submitted have had a conviction, suspension, or revocation activity
21	posted during the period specified in the contract; and
22	(B) provide a report to the person who submitted
23	the list of the name, date of birth, and driver's license number of
24	the driver.
25	(d) The fee for a report provided by the department under
26	Subsection (c) is \$6 for each group of 100 individuals. The fee for
27	the report is in addition to the fee for each three-year driving

- 1 record provided by the department with the report.
- 2 <u>(e) The department may require a person entering into a</u>
- 3 contract with the department under this section to provide the
- 4 department with a certified check, cashier's check, or bond issued
- 5 by a surety company authorized to do business in this state in an
- 6 amount equal to the first payment due under the contract to
- 7 guarantee the person's performance under the contract.
- 8 (f) To the fullest extent practicable, the services of the
- 9 department under a contract entered into under this section shall
- 10 be provided by, through, or in conjunction with the interactive
- 11 system established under Section 521.055.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
