Section 615.021(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (a) A survivor of an individual listed under Section 615.003 8 is eligible for the payment of assistance under this chapter if: 9 (1) the listed individual died in the course of the 10 11 individual's duty performed in the individual's position as 12 described by Section 615.003 as a result of: 13 (A) exposure to a risk: 14 (i) [(A)] that is inherent in the duty; or (ii) [(B)] to which the general public is 15 16 not customarily exposed; or (B) a motor vehicle accident; and 17 18 (2) the survivor is: 19 (A) the surviving spouse of the listed individual; 20 a surviving child of the listed individual, 21 (B) 22 if there is no surviving spouse; or (C) a surviving parent of the listed individual, 23 24 if there is no surviving spouse or child.

1 SECTION 2. Section 615.072, Government Code, is amended to 2 read as follows:

3 Sec. 615.072. ELIGIBLE SURVIVORS. A survivor of an 4 individual listed under Section 615.071 is eligible for the health 5 insurance benefits provided under this subchapter if:

6 (1) the listed individual died in the course of the 7 individual's duty performed in the individual's position as 8 described by Section 615.071 as a result of:

(A) exposure to a risk:

10 (i) [(A)] that is inherent in the duty; or 11 (ii) [(B)] to which the general public is 12 not customarily exposed; or

13(B) a motor vehicle accident; and14(2) the survivor is:15(A) the surviving spouse of the listed

16 individual; or

(B) a dependent of the listed individual.

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 18 615.021 and 615.072, Government Code, relating to the death of 19 certain public servants, apply only in relation to a death that 20 occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. Matters regarding 21 eligibility, payment, and benefits under Sections 615.021 and 22 615.072, Government Code, in relation to a death that occurs before 23 24 the effective date of this Act, are governed by the law in effect when the death occurs, and the former law is continued in effect for 25 that purpose. 26
