- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 204.104(b) and (c), Occupations Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The Office of Rural Community Affairs shall [establish
- 8 policies for and adopt rules to] administer the rural physician
- 9 assistant loan program, subject to Subsection (c).  $[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$  The
- 10 physician assistant board shall authorize and the medical board
- 11 shall transfer annually the funds designated under Subsection (a)
- 12 to the Office of Rural Community Affairs to administer the loan
- 13 program.
- 14 (c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and the
- 15 Office of Rural Community Affairs by rule shall adopt a memorandum
- of understanding. The memorandum of understanding must require:
- 17 (1) the coordinating board to apply for any federal
- 18 <u>funds for the loan program;</u>
- 19 <u>(2) the coordinating board to transfer any federal</u>
- 20 funds the coordinating board receives for the loan program to the
- 21 Office of Rural Community Affairs; and
- 22 (3) the Office of Rural Community Affairs to perform
- 23 any other necessary activity to administer the loan program,
- 24 including adopting rules and completing reports and applications.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Section 487.052, Government Code, is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 487.052. RULES. The executive committee may adopt
- 4 rules as necessary to implement this chapter <u>and any program the</u>
- 5 office administers in accordance with a memorandum of
- 6 <u>understanding</u>.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
