- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 31, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 31.016 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.016. ENHANCED PUNISHMENT FOR OFFENSE COMMITTED
- 8 AGAINST DISABLED PERSON. (a) In this section:
- 9 <u>(1) "Disabled person" has the meaning assigned by</u>

- 11 (2) "Victim" means an individual who suffers pecuniary
- 12 loss as a result of criminally injurious conduct that occurs in this

- 14 (b) An offense under this chapter, other than an offense

- 14 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an

- by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former
- 18 law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this
- 19 section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this
- 20 Act if any element of the offense was committed before that date.
