3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 521.125, Transportation Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	Sec. 521.125. MEDICAL AND EMERGENCY INFORMATION ON LICENSE.
7	(a) On the reverse side of a driver's license, the department
8	shall:
9	(1) print:
10	(A) "Allergic Reaction to Drugs:";
11	(B) "Directive to physician has been filed at
12	tel. #"; [ <del>and</del> ]
13	(C) "Emergency contact tel. #"; and
14	(D) any medical information provided by the
15	license holder under Section 521.142(h);
16	(2) include to the right of the statements under
17	Subdivisions (1)(B) and (C) a surface on which the license holder
18	may write the appropriate telephone number; and
19	(3) include to the left of each of the statements under
20	Subdivisions (1)(B) and (C) a box that the license holder may use to
21	indicate for what purpose the telephone number applies.
22	(b) In addition to the requirements of Subsection
23	(a)(1)(D), the department shall indicate any medical information by
24	a uniform symbol or code on the face of the license in the space

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- 1 where the department indicates a restriction or endorsement.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 521.142, Transportation Code, is amended
- 3 by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 4 (h) The application must provide space for the applicant to
- 5 voluntarily list any health condition that may impede communication
- 6 with a peace officer as evidenced by a written statement from a
- 7 licensed physician.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
