- 2 relating to certain small employer and large employer health
- 3 benefit plans.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 4, Article 3.51-14, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 4. SMALL EMPLOYER COVERAGE. This article does not
- 8 apply to a small employer [An issuer of a group] health benefit plan
- 9 written under Chapter 26 of this code [to a small employer must
- 10 offer the coverage described in Section 3 of this article but is not
- 11 required to provide the coverage if the small employer rejects the
- 12 coverage].
- SECTION 2. Section 1(3), Article 3.51-14, Insurance Code,
- 14 is repealed.
- SECTION 3. Section 2(b), Article 21.52L, Insurance Code, as
- 16 added by Chapter 1106, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular
- 17 Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 (b) "Health benefit plan" <u>does not include</u> [<u>includes</u>] a
- 19 small employer health benefit plan offered in accordance with
- 20 Chapter 26 of this code.
- 21 SECTION 4. Section 2, Article 21.53N, Insurance Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY OF ARTICLE. (a) This article applies
- 24 only to a health benefit plan that provides benefits for medical or

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- 1 surgical expenses incurred as a result of a health condition,
- 2 accident, or sickness, including an individual, group blanket, or
- 3 franchise insurance policy or insurance agreement, a group hospital
- 4 service contract, or an individual or group evidence of coverage or
- 5 similar coverage document that is offered by:
- 6 (1) an insurance company;
- 7 (2) a group hospital service corporation operating
- 8 under Chapter 842 [20] of this code;
- 9 (3) a fraternal benefit society operating under
- 10 Chapter <u>885</u> [10] of this code;
- 11 (4) a stipulated premium insurance company operating
- 12 under Chapter 884 [22] of this code;
- 13 (5) an [a reciprocal] exchange operating under Chapter
- 14 942 [19] of this code;
- 15 (6) a health maintenance organization operating under
- 16 Chapter 843 of this code [the Texas Health Maintenance Organization
- 17 Act (Chapter 20A, Vernon's Texas Insurance Code)];
- 18 (7) a multiple employer welfare arrangement that holds
- 19 a certificate of authority under Chapter 846 [Article 3.95-2] of
- 20 this code; or
- 21 (8) an approved nonprofit health corporation that
- 22 holds a certificate of authority under Chapter 844 [Article 21.52F]
- 23 of this code.
- 24 (b) This article does not apply to [; or

- SECTION 5. Section 1(b), Article 21.53Q, Insurance Code, is

- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 (b) This article does not apply [applies] to a small
- 3 employer health benefit plan written under Chapter 26 of this code.
- 4 SECTION 6. Subchapter H, Chapter 26, Insurance Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Article 26.835 to read as follows:
- Art. 26.835. EXEMPT HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS. (a)
- 7 Notwithstanding any other law, a large employer carrier may offer
- 8 to a large employer an exempt health benefit plan under this
- 9 article.
- 10 (b) An exempt health benefit plan offered under this article
- 11 <u>is not subject to a law that requires coverage or the offer of</u>
- 12 <u>coverage of a health care service or benefit.</u>
- (c) A large employer carrier that offers an exempt health
- 14 benefit plan under this article shall notify the large employer, in
- the form and manner required by the commissioner, that the plan is
- 16 <u>an exempt health benefit plan. The notice must specify each health</u>
- 17 care service or benefit that is not covered under the exempt health
- 18 benefit plan and that would otherwise be required to be covered or
- offered to be covered.
- 20 SECTION 7. This Act applies only to a small employer health
- 21 benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on
- or after January 1, 2004. A small employer health benefit plan that
- 23 is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1,
- 24 2004, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 25 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
