## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the definition of an energy emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 418.004(3), Government Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (3) "Energy emergency" means a temporary statewide,
- 7 regional, or local shortage of petroleum, natural gas, or liquid
- 8 <u>fuel</u> [<u>fuels</u>] energy supplies that makes emergency measures
- 9 necessary to reduce demand or allocate supply.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
