A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to an assessment of school-based mental health and 3 substance abuse programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Texas Education Agency, in conjunction
- 6 with the Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation,
- 7 the Texas Department of Health, and the Texas Commission on Alcohol
- 8 and Drug Abuse, shall assess existing school-based mental health
- 9 and substance abuse programs. The assessment must include
- 10 recommendations regarding further development of such programs,
- 11 including the incorporation of information regarding substance
- 12 abuse prevention, mental health education, and access to related
- 13 services.
- 14 (b) The Texas Education Agency shall report on the results
- of the assessment to the 79th Legislature not later than January 11,
- 16 2005.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
