AN ACT

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 402.084(b), Labor Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- Information on a claim may be released as provided by 7 Subsection (a) to: 8
- 9 (1) the employee or the employee's legal beneficiary;
- employee's or legal beneficiary's 10 (2) the the 11
- representative;

- a potential subclaimant under Section 409.009 that 23 (8)
- is an insurance carrier that has adopted an antifraud plan under 24

- 2 such a potential subclaimant.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 402.084, Labor Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Subsections (c-1), (c-2), and (c-3) to read as follows:
- 5 (c-1) An insurance carrier described by Subsection (a)(8) or
- 6 an authorized representative of the insurance carrier may submit to
- 7 the commission on a monthly basis a written request for claims
- 8 information. The commission shall provide the claims information
- 9 on a monthly basis in an electronic format to the insurance carrier
- 10 or representative. The information provided under this subsection
- 11 must include:
- 12 (1) the full name of the workers' compensation
- 13 <u>claimant;</u>
- 14 (2) the social security number of the workers'
- 15 <u>compensation claimant;</u>
- 16 (3) the date of birth of the workers' compensation
- 17 claimant;
- 18 (4) the name of the employer of the workers'
- 19 compensation claimant;
- 20 <u>(5)</u> the date of the injury;
- 21 (6) a description of the type of injury or the body
- 22 part affected, including the workers' compensation claimant's
- 23 <u>description of how the injury occurred;</u>
- 24 (7) the treating doctor;
- 25 (8) the name, address, and claim number of the
- 26 insurance carrier handling the claim;
- 27 (9) the name of the insurance adjustor handling the

1 claim; and 2 (10) the identifying number assigned to the claim by the commission and the commission field office handling the claim. 3 4 (c-2) A potential subclaim identified by an insurance carrier described by Subsection (a)(8) or an authorized 5 6 representative of the insurance carrier may form the basis for the identification and prosecution of a subclaim under this subtitle. 7 (c-3) Information received under this section by an 8 9 insurance carrier described by Subsection (a)(8) or an authorized representative of the insurance carrier remains subject to 10 confidentiality requirements of this subtitle while in the 11 possession of the insurance carrier or representative. However, 12 the following laws do not prohibit the commission from disclosing 13 14 full information regarding a claim as necessary to determine if a 15 valid subclaim exists: (1) Chapter 552, Government Code; 16 17 (2) Chapter 159, Occupations Code; or

20 SECTION 3. Section 402.084(d), Labor Code, is amended to read as follows:

(d) [Information on a claim relating to a subclaimant under Subsection (b)(8) may include information, in an electronic data format, on all workers' compensation claims necessary to determine if a subclaim exists. The information on a claim remains subject to confidentiality requirements while in the possession of a subclaimant or representative.] The commission by rule may

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- 1 establish a reasonable fee for all information requested by an
- 2 insurance carrier described by Subsection (a)(8) or an authorized
- 3 representative of the insurance carrier [under this subsection] in
- 4 an electronic data format [by subclaimants or authorized
- 5 representatives of subclaimants]. The commission shall adopt rules
- 6 under Section 401.024(d) to establish:
- 7 (1) reasonable security parameters for all transfers
- 8 of information requested under this section [subsection] in
- 9 electronic data format; and
- 10 (2) requirements regarding the maintenance of
- 11 electronic data in the possession of <u>an insurance carrier described</u>
- 12 by Subsection (a)(8) or an authorized representative of the
- 13 insurance carrier [a subclaimant or the subclaimant's
- 14 representative].
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 16 applies only to a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on
- 17 a compensable injury that occurs on or after that date. A claim
- 18 based on a compensable injury that occurs before that date is
- 19 governed by the law in effect on the date that the compensable
- 20 injury occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
