## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to funding for the Texas Academy of Mathematics and
- 3 Science.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.156, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (g) and (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) From the total amount of funds appropriated for
- 8 allotments under this section, the commissioner shall, each fiscal
- 9 year, withhold an amount determined by the commissioner and
- 10 distribute that amount to the Texas Academy of Mathematics and
- 11 Science under Section 105.301.
- (h) After deducting the amount withheld under Subsection
- 13 (g) from the total amount of funds appropriated for allotments
- 14 under this section, the commissioner shall reduce each district's
- tier one allotments in the same manner described for a reduction in
- 16 allotments under Section 42.253 and shall allocate funds to each
- 17 district accordingly. A reduction made under this subsection to an
- 18 allotment does not affect the computation of students in weighted
- 19 average daily attendance for purposes of Subchapter F.
- SECTION 2. Section 105.301, Education Code, is amended by
- 21 amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 22 follows:
- (e) The academy is not subject to the provisions of this
- 24 code, or to the rules of the Texas Education Agency, regulating

- public schools, except that:
- 2 (1) professional employees of the academy are entitled
- 3 to the limited liability of an employee under Section 22.051 or
- 4 22.052;
- 5 (2) a student's attendance at the academy satisfies
- 6 compulsory school attendance requirements; and
- 7 (3) for each student enrolled, the academy is entitled
- 8 to allotments from the foundation school program under Chapter 42
- 9 as if the academy were a school district without a tier one local
- share for purposes of Section 42.253[, except that the academy has a
- 11 local share applied that is equivalent to the local fund assignment
- 12 of the Denton Independent School District].
- (f) For purposes of Subsection (e)(3), if in any academic
- 14 year the amount of the allotments to the academy from the foundation
- school program exceed \$366,825, the portion of the allotments that
- 16 <u>exceeds that amount must be funded by funds withheld by the</u>
- 17 commissioner under Section 42.156(g).
- SECTION 3. Section 105.301(e), Education Code, as amended
- by this Act, applies beginning with the 2003-2004 academic year.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
