5	SECTION 1. Section 105.301, Education Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
7	follows:
8	(e) The academy is not subject to the provisions of this
9	code, or to the rules of the Texas Education Agency, regulating
10	public schools, except that:
11	(1) professional employees of the academy are entitled
12	to the limited liability of an employee under Section 22.051 or
13	22.052;
14	(2) a student's attendance at the academy satisfies
15	compulsory school attendance requirements; and
16	(3) for each student enrolled, the academy is entitled
17	to allotments from the foundation school program under Chapter 42
18	as if the academy were a school district without a tier one local
19	share for purposes of Section 42.253[, except that the academy has a
20	local share applied that is equivalent to the local fund assignment
21	of the Denton Independent School District].
22	(f) If in any academic year the amount of the allotments
23	under Subsection (e)(3) exceeds the amount of state funds paid to
24	the academy under this section in the fiscal year ending August 31,

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1 2003, the commissioner shall set aside from the total amount of 2 funds to which school districts are entitled under Section 42.253(c) an amount equal to the excess amount and shall distribute 3 4 that amount to the academy. After deducting the amount set aside and paid to the academy by the commissioner under this subsection, 5 6 the commissioner shall reduce the amount to which each district is entitled under Section 42.253(c) in the manner described by Section 7 42.253(h). A determination of the commissioner under this section 8 is final and may not be appealed. 9 SECTION 2. Section 105.301(e), Education Code, as amended 10 by this Act, applies beginning with the 2003-2004 academic year. 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 12
