 18 criminal investigation of a misdemeanor and makes the statement to:
- 19 (1) a peace officer conducting the investigation; or
- 20 (2) an employee of a law enforcement agency that is 21 authorized by the agency to conduct the investigation and that the 22 actor knows is conducting the investigation.
- 23 <u>(c)</u> In this section, "law enforcement agency" has the 24 meaning assigned by Article 59.01, Code of Criminal Procedure.
