(a) A person commits an offense if, with 8 intent to deceive, he knowingly makes a false statement that is 9 material to the $[\frac{1}{2}]$ criminal investigation of a felony and makes the 10 11 statement to: 12 (1)a peace officer conducting the investigation; or 13 an [any] employee of a law enforcement agency that (2) 14 is authorized by the agency to conduct the investigation and that the actor knows is conducting the investigation. 15 A person commits an offense if, with intent to deceive, 16 (b) he knowingly makes a false statement that is material to the 17 criminal investigation of a misdemeanor and makes the statement to: 18 (1) a peace officer conducting the investigation; or 19 (2) an employee of a law enforcement agency that is 20 21 authorized by the agency to conduct the investigation and that the actor knows is conducting the investigation. 22 (c) In this section, "law enforcement agency" has the 23 meaning assigned by Article 59.01, Code of Criminal Procedure. 24

1 (d) [(c)] An offense under <u>Subsection (a) is a state jail</u> 2 <u>felony. An offense under Subsection (b)</u> [this section] is a Class B 3 misdemeanor.

4 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 6 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 7 8 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of 9 this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the effective 10 11 date.
