## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 406.096(a) and (b), Labor Code, are
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A governmental entity that enters into a building or
- 9 construction contract shall require the contractor to certify in
- 10 writing that the contractor provides workers' compensation
- insurance coverage for each employee of the contractor employed on
- 12 the public project. This subsection applies only to a contractor
- 13 who enters into building or construction contracts with the
- 14 governmental entity for which the total dollar amount in a fiscal
- 15 year exceeds \$9,000.
- 16 (b) Each subcontractor on <u>a</u> [the] public project <u>subject to</u>
- 17 <u>Subsection (a)</u> shall provide such a certificate relating to
- 18 coverage of the subcontractor's employees to the general
- 19 contractor, who shall provide the subcontractor's certificate to
- 20 the governmental entity.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 22 applies only to a contract for building or construction between a
- 23 governmental entity and a contractor that is entered into on or
- 24 after that date. A contract entered into before the effective date

- of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract
- 2 was entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 3 purpose.
