4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 21.106(a), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) <u>A school district may return</u> [In lieu of discharging] a
8	teacher employed under a continuing <u>or</u> [contract, terminating a
9	teacher employed under a] term contract[, or not renewing a
10	teacher's term contract, a school district may, with the written
11	consent of the teacher, return the teacher] to probationary
12	contract status <u>:</u>
13	(1) for any consideration specified for that purpose
14	in the teacher's employment contract with the district; or
15	(2) on any other basis agreed to in writing by the
16	teacher.
17	SECTION 2. Section 21.106(b), Education Code, is repealed.
18	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
