## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to commercial fishing of catfish in Toledo Bend Reservoir.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 66, Parks and Wildlife
- 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 66.120 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 66.120. CATFISH CAUGHT ON LOUISIANA SIDE OF TOLEDO
- 7 BEND RESERVOIR. (a) In this section, "commercial fisherman" has
- 8 the meaning assigned by Section 47.001.
- 9 (b) Any limits on the length, possession, or number of
- 10 catfish caught in this state by commercial fishermen do not apply to
- 11 catfish caught on the Louisiana side of the Toledo Bend Reservoir.
- 12 (c) A commercial fisherman shall tag catfish caught on the
- 13 Louisiana side of the Toledo Bend Reservoir before transporting the
- 14 fish into and unloading the fish in this state.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 66.121, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 66.121. PENALTY. A person who violates Section
- 18 66.109, 66.110, 66.111, or  $\underline{66.120}$  [ $\underline{66.117(b)}$ ] of this code or a
- 19 regulation adopted under Section 66.115 of this code commits an
- 20 offense that is a Class C Parks and Wildlife Code misdemeanor.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
