5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 7, Water Code, is amended

by adding Section 7.0535 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 7.0535. ALTERNATIVE MAXIMUM ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY

9 FOR CERTAIN SMALL COUNTIES. Notwithstanding any other provision of

this code or of the Health and Safety Code, a penalty imposed under

11 this subchapter on a county with a population of less than 75,000

for a violation of a statute under the commission's jurisdiction or

of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued under such a statute

14 may not exceed the amount of the penalty that would be imposed on

the county for the violation of a federal rule, order, or permit for

the same or similar type of violation, if the behavior or incident

that subjects the county to the penalty may result in the county

18 being subject to a federal penalty.

19 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 7, Water Code, is amended

20 by adding Section 7.1045 to read as follows:

21 Sec. 7.1045. ALTERNATIVE MAXIMUM CIVIL PENALTY FOR CERTAIN

22 SMALL COUNTIES. Notwithstanding any other provision of this code

or of the Health and Safety Code, a civil penalty a court imposes on

24 a county with a population of less than 75,000 for a violation of a

- 2 an order or permit issued under such a statute may not exceed the
- 3 amount of the civil penalty that would be imposed on the county for
- 4 the violation of a federal rule, order, or permit for the same or
- 5 similar type of violation, if the behavior or incident that
- 6 subjects the county to the penalty may result in the county being
- 7 subject to a federal penalty.
- 8 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 5, Water Code, is amended
- 9 by adding Section 5.135 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 5.135. ALTERNATIVE ENVIRONMENTAL STANDARDS FOR
- 11 CERTAIN SMALL COUNTIES. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- this code or of the Health and Safety Code, the commission by rule
- 13 shall adopt standards under environmental statutes under the
- 14 commission's jurisdiction so that each environmental standard
- applicable to a county with a population of less than 75,000 to
- 16 which there is a comparable federal environmental standard also
- 17 applicable to the county is not more stringent than that federal
- 18 standard.
- 19 SECTION 4. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 20 (b) Sections 7.0535 and 7.1045, Water Code, as added by this
- 21 Act, apply only to:
- (1) a violation that occurs on or after September 1,
- 23 2003; and
- 24 (2) a suit to recover a civil penalty under Section
- 7.105, Water Code, that is instituted on or after September 1, 2003,
- 26 for a violation that occurs on or after that date.
- 27 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall

- 1 adopt rules under Section 5.135, Water Code, as added by this Act,
- 2 as soon as practicable. The rules must be effective not later than
- 3 January 31, 2004.
