- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 2.08, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Art. 2.08. DISQUALIFIED. (a) District and county
- 9 attorneys shall not be of counsel adversely to the State in any
- 10 case, in any court, nor shall they, after they cease to be such
- officers, be of counsel adversely to the State in any case in which
- 12 they have been of counsel for the State.
- (b) A spousal relationship between an attorney representing
- 14 the state and an attorney representing a defendant is not a cause
- 15 for disqualification unless otherwise required by this code, the
- 16 constitution of this state, or the constitution of the United
- 17 <u>States.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
