## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to a motor vehicle liability insurance database.	
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:	

- SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 601, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 601.024 to read as follows:
- Sec. 601.024. LIABILITY INSURANCE DATABASE. (a) This
  section applies to a policy of motor vehicle liability insurance
  issued to a resident of this state.
- 9 (b) The department shall maintain a database containing
  10 information about policies to which this section applies that have
  11 expired or been canceled. On request of a law enforcement agency or
  12 other person the department by rule determines has a legitimate
  13 need for the information, the department shall provide information
  14 from the database about whether a specific policy has expired or
  15 been canceled.
- 16 <u>(c) The department shall adopt rules requiring motor</u>
  17 <u>vehicle insurers to provide information necessary to maintain the</u>
  18 <u>database.</u>
- 19 (d) The motor vehicle liability account is an account in the
  20 general revenue fund. Money in the account may be used only to
  21 maintain the database established under this section.
- (e) An annual assessment is imposed on each motor vehicle
  insurer at a rate of 50 cents for each policy of motor vehicle
  liability insurance issued, delivered, or renewed by the insurer to

- a resident of this state. The comptroller shall collect the
  assessment and deposit the money to the credit of the motor vehicle
  liability account. The comptroller may require a motor vehicle
  insurer to provide information the comptroller considers necessary
  to determine the number of policies issued, delivered, or renewed
- 5 to determine the number of policies issued, delivered, or renewed
- 6 by the insurer that are subject to the assessment.
- 7 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 8 (b) The Department of Public Safety shall establish the 9 database required by Section 601.024, Transportation Code, as added 10 by this Act, not later than September 1, 2004. The assessment 11 established by that section applies to a policy of motor vehicle 12 liability insurance issued, delivered, or renewed by an insurer to 13 a resident of this state on or after the effective date of this Act.
