## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to prohibiting a governmental entity from disclosing
3	personal information relating to certain persons who hold a private
4	pesticide applicator license.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 76, Agriculture Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 76.119 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 76.119. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION RELATING TO PRIVATE
9	PESTICIDE APPLICATOR LICENSE HOLDERS. (a) In this section,
10	"predator control device" means a device that incorporates an
11	active ingredient and is used for the control of livestock
12	predators.
13	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a governmental
14	entity in this state may not disclose the name, address, or
15	telephone number of a person who holds a private pesticide
16	applicator license issued under this subchapter and who is
17	authorized to use a predator control device if disclosure of the
18	person's name, address, or telephone number would reveal that the
19	person:
20	(1) is authorized to use a predator control device;
21	(2) has used a predator control device; or
22	(3) has the intent to use a predator control device.
23	(c) A governmental entity may disclose to the following the
24	name, address, or telephone number of a person who holds a private

- 1 pesticide applicator license issued under this subchapter, who is
- 2 authorized to use a predator control device, and who either has used
- 3 <u>a predator control device or has the intent to use a predator</u>
- 4 control device:
- 5 (1) a person who holds a pesticide dealer license
- 6 under Section 76.071 and is authorized to distribute predator
- 7 control devices;
- 8 (2) another governmental entity in this state in
- 9 connection with official business;
- 10 (3) the United States Environmental Protection Agency
- 11 under a cooperative agreement entered into with that agency;
- 12 (4) any other agency of the United States that
- 13 provides the governmental entity with an administrative or judicial
- 14 subpoena for the information; or
- 15 <u>(5) the appropriate agency or court in an</u>
- 16 <u>administrative or judicial proceeding in which the private</u>
- 17 pesticide applicator license holder is a defendant.
- 18 (d) A governmental entity and the officers and employees of
- 19 the governmental entity are immune from civil or criminal liability
- 20 for an unintentional violation of this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

20	(3) information identifying the land on which a
21	predator control device has been used, is being used, or is intended
22	to be used, if disclosure of the information would reveal the name,
23	address, or telephone number of the owner or operator of the land.
