- 9 7, Property Code, that is located in whole or in part:
- 10 (1) in a county with a population of 2.8 million or
- 11 more; or
- 12 (2) in a county with a population of 250,000 or more
- 13 that is adjacent to the Gulf of Mexico and that is adjacent to a
- 14 county having a population of 2.8 million or more.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
