- 6 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to a decision on a claim under Subchapter F, Chapter 74, Property
- 8 Code, that is rendered on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 9 decision on a claim rendered before the effective date of this Act
- 10 is governed by the law in effect at the time the decision was
- 11 rendered, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 12 purpose.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
