H.B. No. 1478

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to the creation of an additional judicial district in
3 Parker County.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code, is
6 amended by adding Section 24.557 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 24.557. 413TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (PARKER COUNTY). The
8 413th Judicial District is composed of Parker County.

9 SECTION 2. Section 32.184(a), Government Code, is amended
10 to read as follows:

11 (a) The Commissioners Court of Parker County may budget for
12 and pay the judges [~~judge~~] of the 43rd and 413th judicial districts
13 [~~Judicial District~~] an annual salary not to exceed \$7,800 for
14 performing judicial and administrative services.

15 SECTION 3. Section 43.125, Government Code, is amended to
16 read as follows:

17 Sec. 43.125. 43RD JUDICIAL DISTRICT. The voters of the 43rd
18 Judicial District elect a district attorney who represents the
19 state in all cases before the 43rd and 413th district courts.

20 SECTION 4. Section 152.1901(b), Human Resources Code, is
21 amended to read as follows:

22 (b) The [~~district court~~] judge of the 43rd Judicial District
23 is the chairman of the board.

24 SECTION 5. The 413th Judicial District is created and this
