| 12 | chiropractor who examines a student to determine the student's |
| 13 | physical fitness to participate in a sports activity sponsored or |
| 14 | sanctioned by the University Interscholastic League shall provide |
| 15 | the student and the student's parent or guardian with written |
| 16 | notification, in the form and with the specific content adopted |
