- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 33.087 to read as follows:
- 9 <u>Sec. 33.087. NOTIFICATION BY PHYSICIAN CONCERNING CERTAIN</u>
- 10 INJURIES. (a) A physician who examines a student to determine the

- 13 shall provide the student and the student's parent or guardian with
