8	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
9	amended by adding Section 33.087 to read as follows:
10	Sec. 33.087. NOTIFICATION BY PHYSICIAN CONCERNING CERTAIN
11	INJURIES. (a) A physician who examines a student to determine the
12	student's physical fitness to participate in a sports activity
13	sponsored or sanctioned by a school district, an open-enrollment
14	charter school, or the University Interscholastic League shall
15	provide the student and the student's parent or guardian with
16	written notification, in the form and with the specific content
17	adopted jointly by the agency, the Texas Department of Health, and
18	the Texas Traumatic Brain Injury Advisory Council, that explains:
19	(1) the risk of secondary injury resulting from head
20	trauma suffered during a sports activity;
21	(2) the types of secondary injury that may occur; and
22	(3) the symptoms of secondary injury.
23	(b) A physician who examines a student because the student

has been injured in a sports activity sponsored or sanctioned by a

- 1 school district, an open-enrollment charter school, or the
- 2 University Interscholastic League shall provide the student and the
- 3 student's parent or guardian with the written notification required
- 4 <u>under Subsection (a).</u>
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
