            SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
        amended by adding Section 33.087 to read as follows:

        PROFESSIONALS CONCERNING INJURIES RESULTING FROM HEAD TRAUMA. (a)
        A physician, physician's assistant, nurse practitioner, or

        physical fitness to participate in a sports activity sponsored or
        sanctioned by the University Interscholastic League shall provide
        the student and the student's parent or guardian with written
        notification, in the form and with the specific content adopted
