A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to notification provided by certain health care professionals to students and parents or guardians of students who participate in extracurricular sports activities sponsored or sanctioned by the University Interscholastic League.

BE IT ÉNACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 33.087 to read as follows:

Sec. 33.087. NOTIFICATION BY CERTAIN HEALTH PROFESSIONALS CONCERNING INJURIES RESULTING FROM HEAD TRAUMA. (a) A physician, physician's assistant, nurse practitioner, or chiropractor who examines a student to determine the student's physical fitness to participate in a sports activity sponsored or sanctioned by the University Interscholastic League shall provide the student and the student's parent or guardian with written notification, in the form and with the specific content adopted jointly by the agency, the Texas Department of Health, the Texas Traumatic Brain Injury Advisory Council, and the University Interscholastic League, that explains:

(1) the risk of secondary injury resulting from head

trauma suffered during a sports activity;

(2) the types of secondary injury that may occur; and

the symptoms of secondary injury.

(b) A physician, physician's assistant, nurse practitioner, chiropractor who examines a student because the student has been injured in a sports activity sponsored or sanctioned by the University Interscholastic League shall provide the student and the student's parent or guardian with the written notification required under Subsection (a).

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
