A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to compensatory time off for certain persons who are
- 3 employed by the state as peace officers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 662.005(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Section 662.010, and
- 8 notwithstanding Section 659.015 or another law, a state employee
- 9 who is a peace officer commissioned by a state officer or state
- 10 agency listed under Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, [the
- 11 Department of Public Safety] and who is required to work on a
- 12 national or state holiday that falls on a Saturday or Sunday is
- 13 entitled to compensatory time off at the rate of one hour for each
- 14 hour worked on the holiday.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
