- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 7, Chapter 429, Acts of the 70th
- 6 Legislature, Regular Session, 1987, is amended by adding
- 7 Subsections (d), (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) The district is divided into five numbered,
- 9 single-member districts for electing directors. The board may
- 10 revise the single-member districts as necessary or appropriate.
- 11 (e) The board shall revise the single-member districts as
- 12 soon as practicable after the publication of each federal decennial
- 13 census as the board considers appropriate to reflect population
- 14 changes.
- 15 (f) When the board revises the single-member districts
- 16 under Subsection (e), the board shall place two of the districts
- 17 entirely within the boundaries of the City of Austin, as they exist
- 18 at that time. Changes in the boundaries of the City of Austin
- 19 <u>between revisions of the single-member districts under Subsection</u>
- 20 (e) do not affect the boundaries of the single-member districts.
- 21 (g) When the boundaries of the single-member districts are
- changed, a director in office on the effective date of the change,
- or elected or appointed before the effective date of the change to a
- 24 term of office beginning on or after the effective date of the

- change, is entitled to serve the term or the remainder of the term
- 2 in the single-member district to which elected or appointed even
- 3 though the change in boundaries places the person's residence
- 4 outside the single-member district for which the person was elected
- 5 or appointed.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
