- SECTION 1. Sections 26.042(a) and (d), Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A county court has concurrent jurisdiction with the
- 7 justice courts in civil cases in which the matter in controversy
- 8 exceeds \$200 in value but does not exceed <u>\$10,000</u> [\$5,000],
- 9 exclusive of interest.
- 10 (d) A county court has concurrent jurisdiction with the
- 11 district court in civil cases in which the matter in controversy
- 12 exceeds \$500 but does not exceed $\frac{$10,000}{$}$ [\$5,000], exclusive of
- 13 interest.
- SECTION 2. Section 27.031(a), Government Code, is amended
