| 5 | SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Property Code, is |
| 6 | amended by adding Section 21.0121 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 21.0121. CONDEMNATION TO ACQUIRE WATER RIGHTS. (a) In |
| 8 | addition to the contents prescribed by Section 21.012(b), a |
| 9 | condemnation petition filed by a political subdivision of this |
| 10 | state for the purpose of acquiring rights to groundwater or surface |
| 11 | water must state that the political subdivision has: |

- 12 (1) prepared a drought contingency plan;
- 13 (2) developed and implemented a water conservation

 14 plan that will result in the highest practicable levels of water

 15 conservation and efficiency achievable in the political

 16 subdivision's jurisdiction;
- 17 (3) pursued the availability of feasible and
 18 practicable alternative water supplies; and
- 19 <u>(4) made a bona fide good faith effort to acquire the</u>
 20 <u>rights to the water the political subdivision proposes to condemn</u>
 21 by voluntary purchase or lease.
- 22 <u>(b) A court shall deny the right to condemn unless the</u>
 23 <u>political subdivision submits proof to the court that the political</u>
 24 <u>subdivision has met the requirements of Subsection (a).</u>

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
