7	Sec. 36.207. USE OF PERMIT FEES AUTHORIZED BY SPECIAL LAW.
8	A district may use funds obtained from permit fees, export fees, or
9	user fees collected pursuant to the special law governing the
10	district for any purpose consistent with the district's certified
11	water management plan including, without limitation, making
12	grants, loans, or contractual payments to achieve, facilitate, or
13	expedite:
14	(1) reductions in groundwater pumping; [ər]
15	(2) [the] development or distribution of alternative
16	water supplies <u>;</u>
17	(3) mitigation projects; or
18	(4) other projects intended to benefit residents of
19	the district, including:
20	(A) economic development; or
21	(B) educational programs related to water use.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
