- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.004, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (a) A discount or other form of pricing flexibility may not
- 9 be:
- 10 <u>(1) unreasonably</u> preferential, prejudicial, <u>or</u>
- 11 discriminatory; or
- 12 $\underline{(2)}$ [τ] predatory[τ] or anticompetitive.
- 13 (c) This title does not prohibit an offer based on a
- 14 reasonable business purpose, including an offer made to a selected
- customer or a group of customers in response to a competitor's offer
- or a former customer's acceptance of a competitor's offer. A price
- 17 that is set at or above the long run incremental cost of a service is
- 18 presumed not to be a predatory price.
- 19 (d) An offer made under Subsection (c) must be made in
- 20 compliance with Chapter 43, Business & Commerce Code, as added by
- 21 Chapter 1429, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
