For purposes of Subchapter 8 9 I, Chapter 659, Government Code: (1) the land office, for the sole purpose of managing 10 the Adopt-A-Map/Adopt-A-Document Program, is considered 11 an 12 eligible charitable organization entitled to participate in the state employee charitable campaign; and 13 14 (2) a state employee is entitled to authorize a deduction for contributions to the land office for the purposes of 15 16 managing the Adopt-A-Map/Adopt-A-Document Program as a charitable contribution under Section 659.132, Government Code, and the land 17 18 office may use the contributions for the purpose of preserving historic maps and documents under that program. 19 Land Office SECTION 2. The General is entitled 20 to 21 participate in the state employee charitable campaign conducted 22 during the autumn of 2003 without regard to any limitation on the time during which an organization must apply to participate in the 23

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
