- 2 relating to the regulation of certain combative sports.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2052.253, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 2052.253. GENERAL RULES [KICKBOXING]. (a) A
- 7 professional <u>combative sport</u> [<u>kickboxing</u>] event must be fought on
- 8 the basis of the contestants' best efforts.
- 9 (b) A contestant must wear four-ounce boxing gloves, unless
- 10 the commissioner by rule requires or permits a contestant to wear
- 11 heavier gloves.
- 12 (c) A contestant may deliver blows with a closed-fist to any
- 13 part of the body, except the kidneys and the spine. A closed-fist
- 14 may not be used to deliver blows to the head if one or both of the
- 15 contestants is on the ground.
- 16 (d) A contestant may deliver blows with the knee to any part
- of the body except the kidneys, spine, and head.
- (e) Subsections (c) and (d) do not prohibit a person from
- 19 adopting rules that prohibit the use of a blow permitted by those
- 20 subsections in a particular competition of a combative sport.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
