7	[SCHOOL DISTRICT]. (a) In this section, "service site" means
8	facilities or buildings operated by a public retail customer
9	[school district] or a group of adjacent facilities or buildings
10	operated by a <u>public retail customer</u> [school district] within one
11	contiguous geographical area.
12	(b) Unless the utility is prohibited by other law from
13	providing the service and if sufficient pipeline capacity is
14	available on an existing facility of the utility to provide the
15	service, a gas utility or municipally owned utility may not refuse
16	to provide service to a <u>public retail customer</u> [ <del>school district</del> ] at
17	a service site, at rates established as provided by Subsection (c),
18	the following services:
19	(1) the sale of gas;
20	(2) the transportation of an annual average of $25$ [ $10$ ]
21	million British thermal units or more each day of gas that is:

- 3 A utility shall provide a service described 4 Subsection (b) at rates provided by a written contract negotiated between the utility and the state or a state agency. If the utility 5 6 and the state or state agency are not able to agree to a contract rate, a fair and reasonable rate may be determined for the public 7 8 retail customer [school district], as a rate for a separate class of service, by the railroad commission or other relevant regulatory 9 body pursuant to this chapter. 10
- 11 (d) "Public retail customer" as used herein shall have the 12 same meaning as such term is defined in Section 35.101.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
