8	PROGRAM. (a) In this section, "qualifying hospital" means a
9	hospital eligible for medical assistance disproportionate share
10	funds.
11	(b) The department, in its rules prescribing the method and
12	procedures for the reimbursement of a qualifying hospital under the

- procedures for the reimbursement of a qualifying hospital under the disproportionate share program, must provide for a weight factor of 1.5 for a qualifying hospital:
- 15 <u>(1) that is located in a metropolitan statistical</u>
 16 <u>area, as defined by the United States Office of Management and</u>
 17 Budget, with a population of more than one million; and
- (2) for which at least 40 percent of the hospital's gross revenue during a calendar year is attributable to patients receiving medical assistance or uncompensated care.
- SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementing that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

- 1 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 2 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
