4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 165, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 165.1535 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 165.1535. PERFORMING MEDICAL PROCEDURE WHILE
8	INTOXICATED. (a) In this section, "intoxicated" has the meaning
9	assigned by Section 49.01, Penal Code.
10	(b) A person commits an offense if the person is licensed or
11	regulated under this subtitle and performs a medical procedure
12	while intoxicated.

(c) An offense under this section is a state jail felony.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
