4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 117.012(k), Natural Resources Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(k) The commission by rule shall require the owner or
8	operator of each interstate or intrastate hazardous liquid or
9	carbon dioxide pipeline facility any part of which is located
10	within 1,000 feet of a public school to:
11	(1) develop an emergency response plan in consultation
12	with the fire department in whose jurisdiction the school is
13	located or another local emergency response entity; and
14	(2) mail a copy of the plan by certified mail, return
15	receipt requested, to the superintendent of the school district in
16	which the school is located [present the plan:
17	[(A) at the first annual budget meeting of the
18	board of trustees of the school district in which the school is
19	located after the plan is developed; and
20	[(B) at subsequent annual budget meetings of the
21	board of trustees of the school district on the request of the
22	board].
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
