- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is 5 SECTION 1. 6 amended by adding Section 531.063 to read as follows:
- Sec. 531.063. ENROLLMENT OF CHILDREN IN PUBLIC HEALTH CARE 7 PROGRAMS. (a) In this section, "public health care program" 8 includes the Medicaid program and the state child health plan 9 program created under Chapter 62, Health and Safety Code.
- (b) The commission shall adopt rules requiring a person 11 12 receiving public assistance under a program administered by the 13 commission or a health and human services agency, as a condition of 14 receiving that assistance, to enroll each of the person's dependent children in any public health care program for which the child is 15 eligible. 16
- (c) In implementing the rules adopted under this section, 17 18 the commission or the appropriate health and human services agency 19 must:
- 20 (1) identify any public health care program in which a 21 person is required to enroll a child; and
- 22 (2) assist the person with the procedures required to 23 enroll the child in the identified program.
- (d) The rules adopted under this section must include 24

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- 1 procedures under which the commission or the appropriate health and
- 2 human services agency may exempt a person from the rules for good
- 3 cause. For purposes of this subsection, a person's inability to pay
- 4 any cost associated with enrollment in a public health care program
- 5 must be considered good cause for an exemption.
- 6 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 7 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 8 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 9 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 10 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 11 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 13 applies to a person who receives public assistance from the Health
- 14 and Human Services Commission or a health and human services agency
- on or after that date, regardless of the date on which eligibility
- 16 for that assistance was determined.
