9	candidate, measure, or political party in or within 100 feet of ar
10	outside door through which a voter may enter [a certain distance
11	<pre>from] the building or structure in which the early voting polling</pre>
12	place is located[, as follows:
13	[(1) for a building containing the main early voting
14	polling place, a person may not electioneer in the room in which the
15	polling place is located or within 30 feet of the entrance to the
16	room in which the polling place is located;
17	[(2) for a building that is also used as a precinct
18	polling place, a person may not electioneer within 100 feet of ar
19	outside door through which a voter may enter the building in which
20	the polling place is located; and
21	[(3) for any other structure, a person may not
22	electioneer within 30 feet of the entrance to the voting area].
23	(d) A person commits an offense if the person electioneers

in violation of Subsection (a) [or (b)].
