## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorizing a public junior college to waive a portion
- 3 of the tuition and fees for a student enrolled in a course for joint
- 4 high school-junior college credit.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 130.008(b) and (c), Education Code, are
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The junior college may waive <u>all or part of</u> the tuition 9 and fees [<del>fee</del>] for a high school student enrolled in a course for
- 10 which the student may receive joint credit under this section.
- 11 (c) The contact hours attributable to the enrollment of a
- 12 high school student in a course offered for joint high school and
- 13 junior college credit under this section shall be included in the
- 14 contact hours used to determine the junior college's proportionate
- 15 share of the state money appropriated and distributed to public
- 16 junior colleges under Sections 130.003 and 130.0031, even if the
- junior college waives <u>all or part of</u> the tuition <u>or fees</u> [<del>fee</del>] for
- 18 the student under Subsection (b).
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
