1 AN ACT 2 relating to use of personal leave by school district employees. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 22.003(a), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 (a) A state minimum personal leave program consisting of 7 five days per <u>school</u> year personal leave with no limit on accumulation and transferable among districts shall be provided for 8 school district employees. School districts may provide additional 9 personal leave beyond this minimum. Each employee may use up to two 10 personal leave days per school year for personal business, except 11 12 that the board of trustees of a school district may restrict the timing of the leave and may restrict the leave based on the 13 14 availability of a substitute teacher. The board of trustees [of a school district] may adopt a policy governing an employee's use of 15 other personal leave granted under this subsection, except that the 16 policy may not prohibit a district employee from using any personal 17 leave granted under this subsection for: 18 an illness of the employee; 19 (2) an illness of a member of the employee's immediate 20 21 family; (3) a family emergency, as defined by board policy; or 22 23 (4) a death in the employee's immediate family

24 [restrict the purposes for which the leave may be used].

1 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to the use of personal 2 leave a school district employee accrues on or after September 1, 3 2003. The use of personal leave a school district employee accrues 4 before September 1, 2003, is governed by Section 22.003(a), 5 Education Code, as that law existed on August 31, 2003, and that law 6 is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
