13	the board of trustees may address absenteeism among employees by
14	<u>restricting</u> [ <del>not restrict</del> ] the purposes for which the leave may be
15	used to leave for:
16	(1) an illness of the employee;
17	(2) an illness of a member of the employee's immediate
18	<pre>family;</pre>
19	(3) a family emergency; or
20	(4) a death in the employee's immediate family.
21	SECTION 2. This Act applies only to the use of personal
22	leave a school district employee accrues on or after September 1,
23	2003. The use of personal leave a school district employee accrues
24	before September 1, 2003, is governed by Section 22.003(a),
