- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2054.111, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (d) A state agency that <u>uses</u> [chooses to use] the project
- 8 [under Subsection (b)] shall comply with rules adopted by the
- 9 department, including any rules regarding:
- 10 (1) the appearance of the agency's Internet site and
- 11 the ease with which the site can be used; [and]
- 12 (2) the use of the authority seal; and
- 13 (3) marketing efforts under Subsection (g).
- 14 (g) A state agency that uses the project shall assist the
- authority with marketing efforts regarding the use of the project.
- SECTION 2. Section 2054.125, Government Code, is amended by
- 17 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- (d) Each state agency that maintains a generally accessible
- 19 Internet site and that uses TexasOnline shall include a link to
- 20 <u>TexasOnline on the front page of the site.</u>
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
