- 7 (c) Notwithstanding the time requirements of Subsection
- 8 (a)(12), a person who is the foster parent of a child may file a suit
- 9 to adopt a child for whom the person is providing foster care at any
- 10 time after the person has been approved to adopt the child. The
- 11 standing to file suit under this subsection applies only to the
- 12 adoption of a child who is eligible to be adopted.
- SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 14 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a suit
- 15 affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after the
- 16 effective date of this Act. A suit affecting the parent-child
- 17 relationship filed before that date is governed by the law in effect
- on the date the suit was filed, and the former law is continued in
- 19 effect for that purpose.
