9	the possession of a chemical dispensing device that the actor holds
10	a security officer commission issued by the Texas Commission on
11	Private Security and has received training on the use of the
12	chemical dispensing device by a training program that is:
13	(1) provided by the Commission on Law Enforcement
14	Officer Standards and Education; or
15	(2) approved for the purposes described by this
16	subsection by the Texas Commission on Private Security.
17	SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
18	(b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an
19	offense committed on or after September 1, 2003. An offense
20	committed before September 1, 2003, is covered by the law in effect
21	when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in
22	effect for that purpose. For purposes of this subsection, an
23	offense was committed before September 1, 2003, if any element of
24	the offense was committed before that date.
